

Training Facilities

TAG's purpose built facilities in the north of England are second to none, designed and built to cater for the work at height industry. All training is interactive and delivered using state of the art equipment and methods.

Facilities include a purpose built roof- top training venue containing with a range of associated hazards to contend with, including a fragile roof area, unprotected edges and Radio Frequency.

The center has two training towers, including a 17meter rope access tower with confined space access facility, plus a separate 30meter communications mast for climber training.

Subject to suitability courses can be carried out at client's premises or at one of our regional training facilities situated across the UK.

Medical

Some of the courses at TAG are demanding, requiring a high degree of both physical and mental effort, TAG recommends that all delegates are medically fit and have the required fitness for the intended course. For further guidance please contact TAG.

Arrival & Registration

Unless otherwise agreed all courses start at 0900hrs.

On arrival at TAG delegates should report to reception on the first floor 15mins before course start time. Those persons turning up late for courses may be turned away.

Smoking

There is a No Smoking policy in operation in public areas of the building; designated smoking areas will be pointed out to delegates on arrival.

Refreshments

For those attending training, free tea, coffee and a light buffet lunch is provided throughout the day. Those with any specific dietary requirements please contact TAG.

Training Equipment

TAG can provide all training equipment required for safety courses, however, those persons wishing to use their own equipment may do so by prior arrangement.

Clothing

Delegates to provide their own safety footwear – a pair of treaded climbing boots are essential along with outdoor clothing when necessary.

Photo's

Two passport or a digital photograph are required by those attending courses.

Public transport

There are limited public transport links within walking distance of our training centre. If you are traveling by air or rail, please telephone us in advance to arrange pickup and taxi information.

Visitor Directions

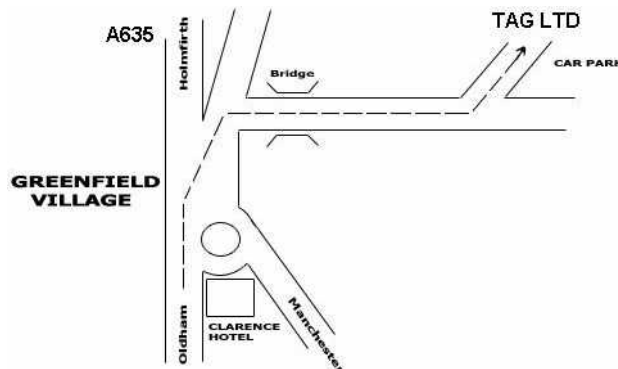
For visitors using satellite navigation, our postcode gives the correct location and usually directs travelers via the following routes: -

1. From the East Midlands or South via the M1 - approx travel time from M1 is 45 minutes. Leave the M1 north of Sheffield at Jct 35A (signed to Manchester). Take the A616 over two islands, then after approx. 11 miles go over next island (ignoring sign left to Manchester). Continue on A616 to New Mill, passing over a narrow bridge, then turn left onto A635 to Holmfirth (signpost obscured). Continue over the ridge and descend into Holmfirth. At the T junction ("Your Nuts" on the left), turn left then follow the road to the right. Turn left at the lights, then at "Compo's Cafe" fork right on A635 to Greenfield. Continue over Saddleworth Moor, and descend into Chew Valley, passing signs to Dovestone Reservoir. Continue until you approach the mini island and take a sharp left U-turn into Tanner Brothers Mill. Follow the TAG signs to the rear of the Mill.

2. From the West Midlands or Southwest via the M6 - approx travel time from M6 is 45 minutes. Leave the M6 at Jct 19 and take A556 Manchester direction. After 3 miles turn onto M56 to Manchester Airport. After passing the Airport, filter left to Stockport on M56 until it joins M60 anticlockwise. Continue on M60 past Stockport and exit at Jct 23 to Ashton-under-Lyne. Turn right onto A635, past Ashton, and follow signs to Barnsley. After 2 miles, filter left before Stalybridge, and stay on A635 for a further 4 miles through Mossley until entering Greenfield. Turn right at the mini island and take the immediate right into Tanner Brothers Mill. Follow the TAG signs to the rear of the Mill.

3. From the North West or North via the M62 - approx travel time from M62 is 25 minutes. Leave the M62 at Jct 20 onto A627(M) south, and take second exit A627 to Oldham. Cross two islands and join Oldham bypass. At island with railway viaduct at end of bypass, take third exit A669 signed to Lees and Holmfirth. After 3 miles enter Grasscroft, joining A670 at Farrars Arms. After half-mile, turn right downhill and round hairpin bend into Greenfield (Chew Valley Road). Continue to the mini island and go straight over, taking your immediate right into Tanner Brothers Mill. Follow the TAG signs to the rear of the Mill.
